CSU, Chico will not be the best fit for everyone, but I have provided some information below that will help you share why it may be an excellent option for many students. We know that making a decision about where to attend university can be a challenge, particularly when someone is unable to visit the school in advance. In order to help students in your network decide if California State University, Chico is the right choice for them, please note the following highlights:

1. A large variety of majors

The <u>College of Business</u> is the largest on campus and its AACSB-accredited programs place it among the top 5% globally. In addition, we hold a unique position as one of only two <u>SAP University Competence Centers</u> in the US. Our <u>College of Engineering</u> is ranked #3 in the US for best value and includes programs in Computer Science, Mechatronics, Mechanical, and Civil Engineering, as well as Concrete Industry Management, Construction Management, and Computer Animation & Game Development. Other highlights include preprofessional programs in Medicine, Dentistry, Law, Physical Therapy, Optometry, Theology, Forensic Science, Veterinary, and Pharmacy.

- 2. We are a traditional <u>college town</u> in California: This means that everything we do is student-focused both in the city and on campus. Most students live on or within walking/biking distance to campus. CSU, Chico is the <u>only</u> CSU with a free <u>ESL Resource Center</u> to support international students in academic programs. The quality of engagement is high with small class sizes, <u>highly active clubs & intramural sports</u>, excellent high-touch support services, and a safe environment compared to large cities. In addition, we have one of California's largest city parks, <u>Bidwell</u>, which starts on campus and stretches into the foothills of the Sierra Nevada Mountains.
- 3. Cost of living is half that of bigger cities: Average rent for a single-bedroom apartment is about \$800 and a private room in a shared house within walking distance from campus is about \$400. This means that the total cost of attendance for one year, estimated at \$30,050 for non-residents, is an excellent value.
- 4. There are limited scholarships available for international students.
