



**Admissions Requirements for First-time Freshmen**

**NO SAT REQUIRED**

- Completion of a university-preparatory secondary or high school program with a 3.0 GPA (B in the U.S. system)
- Completion of university preparatory mathematics courses a grade of C or higher
- Proof of English language proficiency using **one** of the following scores:
  - TOEFL 61 (iBT) or 500PBT/46 Revised
  - IELTS 6.0
  - PTE Academic 47

**English Proficiency Waiver**

- Students who have completed **three years** of full-time academic study at a secondary school in Australia, Great Britain, Anglophone Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, or the United States.

- \$55 application fee
- Submit the following supporting documents to the Office of International Education
  - Official high school transcripts, diploma, mark sheets, and/or exam results (varies by country)
  - English language proficiency – send your score electronically to CSU, Chico!
  - Financial Support Form & Bank Statement
  - Copy of passport photo identification page

**Application Filing Periods**

- Spring: August 1 – September 30
- Fall: October 1 – April 1

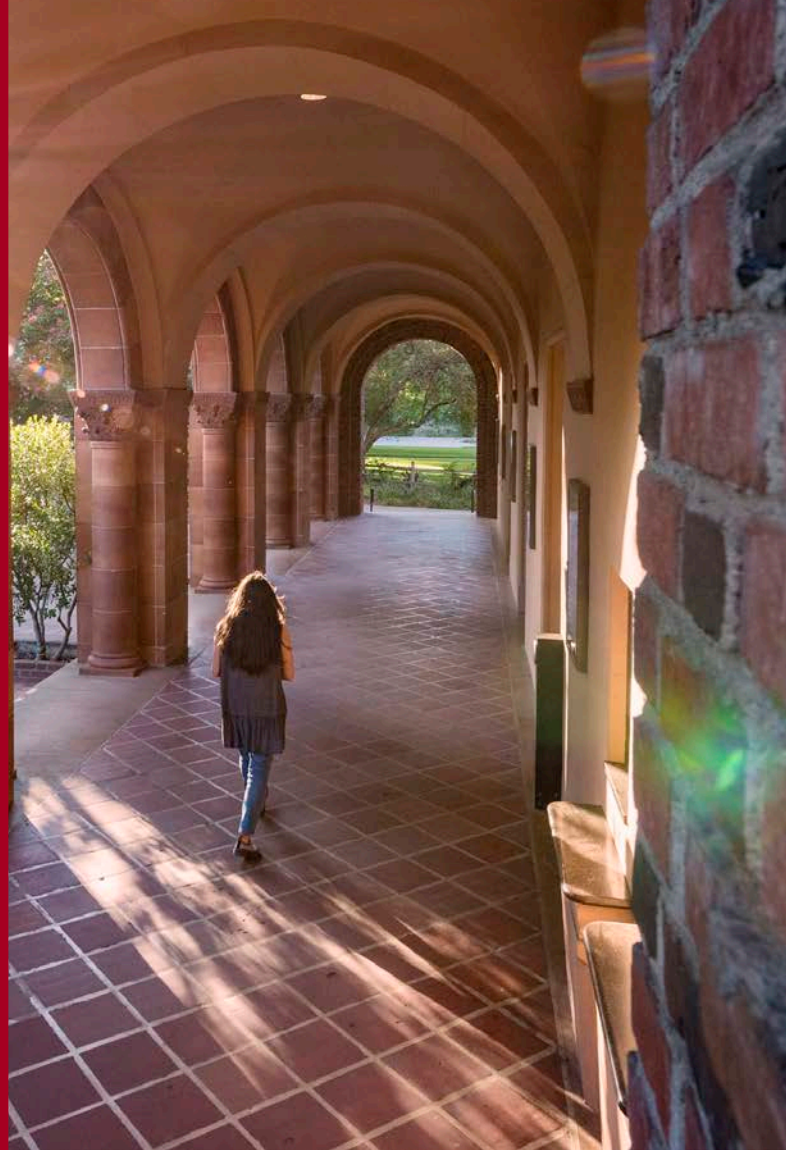
