

International Students How to Apply for First-Time Freshman

Admissions Requirements for First-time Freshmen

• Completion of a university-preparatory secondary or high school program with a 3.0 GPA (B in the U.S. system)

- Completion of university preparatory mathematics courses a grade of C or higher
- Proof of English language proficiency using **one** of the following scores:
 - TOEFL 61 (iBT) or 500PBT/46 Revised
 - o **IELTS 6.0**
 - o PTE Academic 47

English Proficiency Waiver

• Students who have completed **three years** of full-time academic study at a secondary school in Australia, Great Britain, Anglophone Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, or the United States.

Application Requirements

- \$55 application fee

Application Filing Periods

- Spring: August 1 September 30
- Fall: October 1 April 1
- Submit the following supporting documents to the Office of International Education
 - o Official high school transcripts, diploma, mark sheets, and/or exam results (varies by country)
 - English language proficiency send your score electronically to CSU, Chico!
 - Financial Support Form & Bank Statement
 - Copy of passport photo identification page
