



## Admissions Requirements for Graduate Students

- In possession of a degree equivalent to a U.S. bachelor's degree and awarded prior to the start of the graduate program
- A **2.75 GPA in the last 60** semester units and a **3.00 GPA in the last 30** semester units completed based on a 4 point scale
- Qualifying test scores – some programs require GRE or GMAT exams
- Proof of English language proficiency using one of the following scores:
  - **TOEFL 80 (iBT) or 550 (PBT)/60 Revised**
  - **IELTS 6.5**
  - **PTE Academic 59**

### English Proficiency Waivers:

- Students who have completed a undergraduate degree or **three** years of full-time academic study at a secondary school in Australia, Great Britain, Anglophone Canada, New Zealand, Ireland or the US.
- Completion of **Level 7** at the American Language & Culture Institute on the CSU, Chico campus (for programs that offer conditional admission).

## Application Requirements

- \$55 application fee
- Submit the following documents to the Office of International Education
  - **Two** official university transcripts (along with degree verifications) – documents issued in a language other than English must be accompanied by an original, certified, word-for-word English translation
  - English language proficiency – send your test score electronically to CSU, Chico!
  - Additional documents and/or test scores required by the program – see website below for details ([www.csuchico.edu/graduatestudies/about-us/programs-coordinators.shtml](http://www.csuchico.edu/graduatestudies/about-us/programs-coordinators.shtml))
  - Financial Support Form & Bank Statement
  - Copy of passport photo identification page

### Application Filing Periods

- Fall (most programs): October 1 – March 1
    - ANTH/PSYC – priority deadlines January 10<sup>th</sup>/15<sup>th</sup>
    - CMSD/SWRK – deadline January 15<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup>
  - Spring: August 1 – September 15\*
- \*not all programs allow Spring admission**

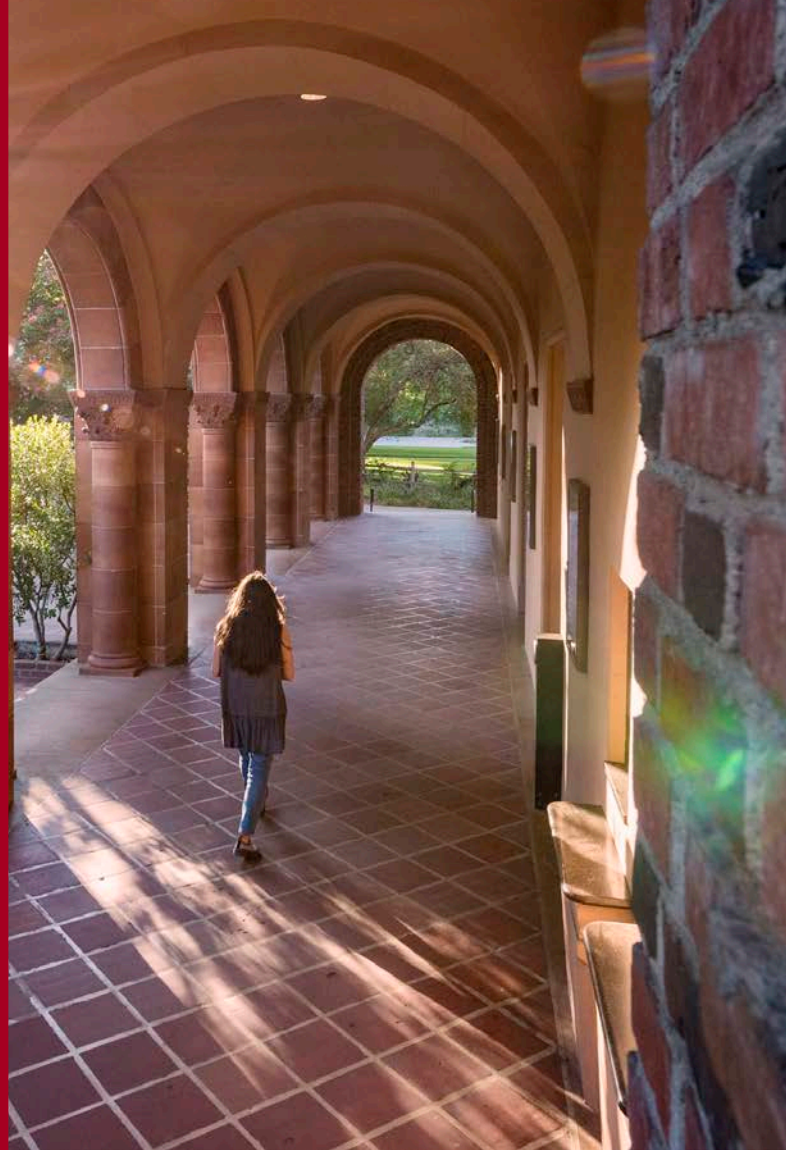
