



Admissions Requirements for Overseas Transfer Students

- 2.40 GPA or B-/C+ average, or the equivalent, on all university coursework completed
- If less than 60 semester units of university coursework have been completed, these additional requirements apply:
 - Completion of a university-preparatory secondary or high school program with a 3.0 GPA (“B” average in the U.S. system)
 - Completion of university preparatory math courses in high school
- Proof of English language proficiency using one of the following scores:
 - TOEFL 61 (iBT) or 500PBT/46 Revised
 - IELTS 6.0
 - PTE Academic 47

English Proficiency Waiver

- Students who have completed **three** years of full-time academic study at a secondary or **two** years of full-time study at a post-secondary school in Australia, Great Britain, Anglophone Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, or the United States.

Application Requirements

- Apply online: www.calstate.edu/apply
- \$55 application fee (pay at time of application)
- Submit supporting documents to the Office of International Education
 - Official academic records – university and/or high school
 - 60+ units completed - high school records are not required.
 - Less than 60 units completed - in addition to submitting university transcripts, please also submit high school transcripts.
 - English language proficiency – send your score electronically to CSU, Chico!
 - Financial support form & bank statement
 - Passport photo identification page

Application Filing Periods

- Spring: August 1 – September 30
- Fall: October 1 – April 1
