### AFRICA

- 1/ It is THE TREE OF LIFE
- 2/ Brandberg African rock art (AD 900)
- 3/ Rosetta stone
- 4/ Siltone sarcophagus of SASOBEK (1000 BC)

### AMERICA

- 1/ Artic hunters on the kayaks wore them (AD 1900/1800)
- 2/ It is made of bentwood.
- 3 / Snow goggles of caribou antler
- 4/ the map was used to negociate lands.

### ASIA

- 1/Mughal India, Miskin Mounted miniature.
- 2/ It comes from the exterior decoration of an Indian temple
- 3/ This carved ivory called the lioness devouring boy » represents an African boy with bracelets being attacked by a lioness.
- 4/ The lion symbolized the power of nature and is often associated with the king.

### OCEANIA

- 1/ They used boomerangs to hunt parrots and ducks as they took off from waterholes
- 2/ In Aboriginal Australia, shields were used in fighting but also in ceremonies
- 3/ This Samoan bonnet made of turtle shell was given to Queen Victoria before 1841
- 4/ It is the Mourner's costume. It was worn during a violent expression of grief when a Tahitian Chef died.
