

A canyon/a lake/the sea/a river/a waterfall/ mountain/a forest/a volcano/a desert

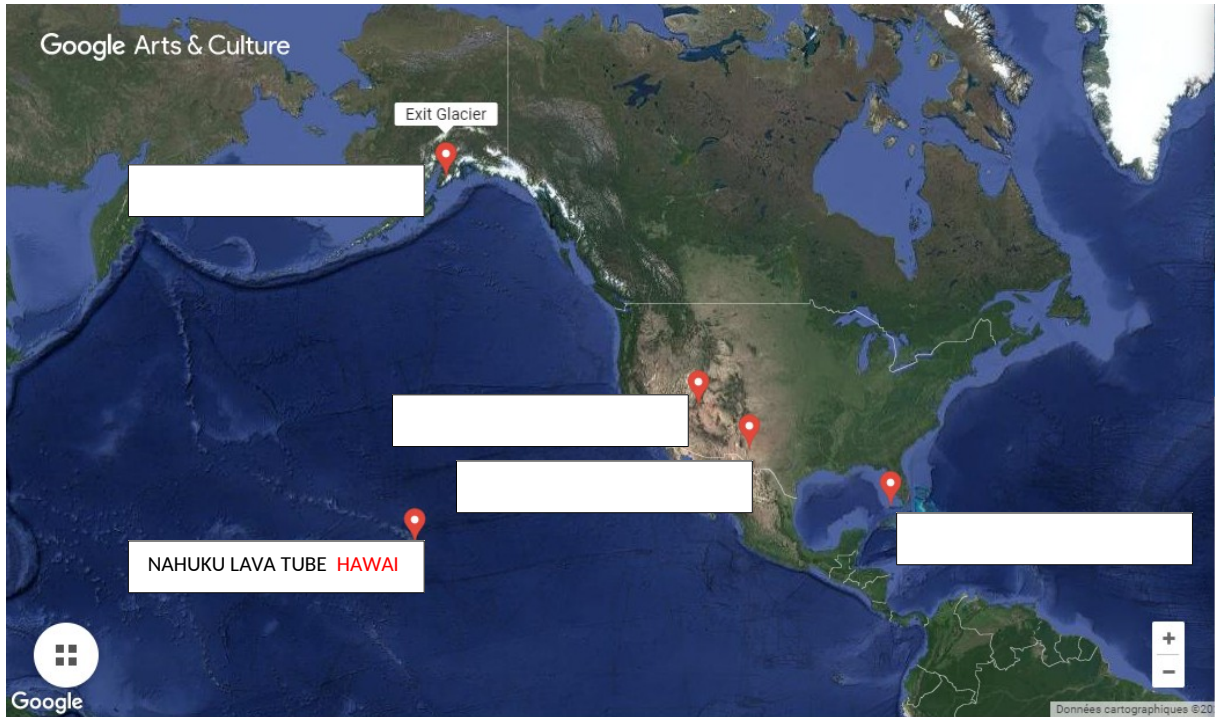

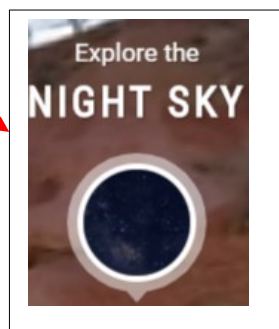
